# Background

- Future medical doctors → determine the medical practice and collaborate with other health professionals and community
- Current medical education should adapt to the regional and global health needs
- Medical students start thinking and collaborating to contribute to their community



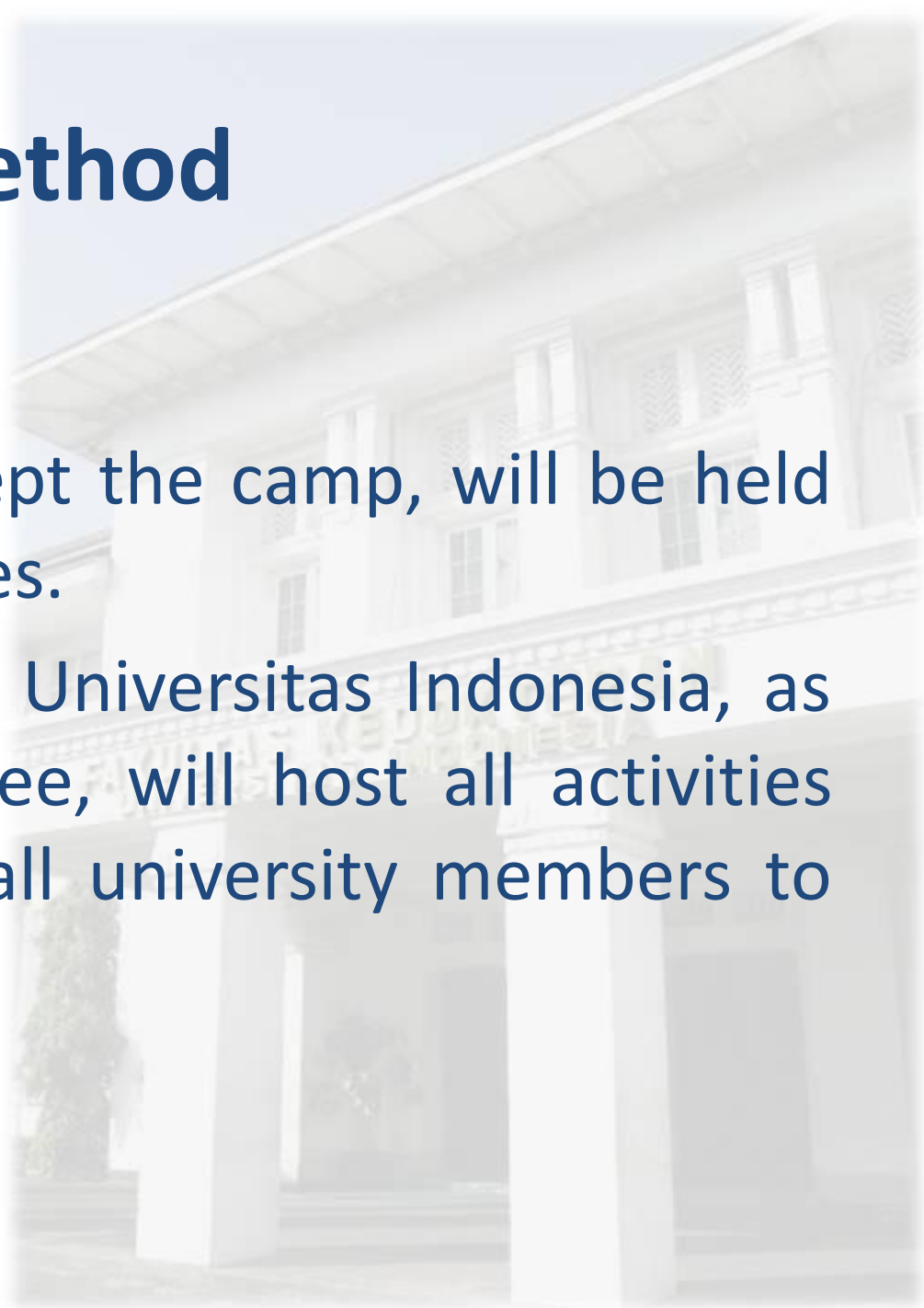
# Aims

- Improving students' skills in developing health projects in community within a collaborative framework
- It encourages South East Asia students to :
  - propose community-based health projects,
  - implement the projects and try to solve any faced constraints in community,
  - deliver comments and criticism to others critically as reviewer, and
  - collaborate actively within related projects



# Method

- Most activities, except the camp, will be held by virtual conferences.
- Faculty of Medicine Universitas Indonesia, as an Ad hoc committee, will host all activities and actively invite all university members to involve.







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# Preparation

- Invited universities to discuss in a teleconference meeting on May 25, 2015
- *Universities can freely choose whether they will do **a new or on-going project**, also their **own theme of project***
- *Final decision of the themes of the projects will be discussed in Deans Meeting on June*

- Potential themes to propose include:
  - infectious disease or tropical infection,
  - urban health,
  - primary care and universal health coverage, and
  - healthy lifestyle

- *Universities should prepare a team that be consisted of **minimally two different levels** of years in order to ensure that the project will be continuously run*
- *This project will be **an initial project** to develop networking between students across countries. At the Student Camp in 2016, students will discuss to develop further, better collaboration*





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# Call for project proposal

- Inviting one project proposal from each university to join
- Internal selection or competition with consideration to general and specific requirements
- A team consisting of 2 to 4 students from, at minimum, two different year levels.
- Deadline: October 1, 2015



# Review of project proposal

- Reviewer
  - Universities submit a faculty member
  - One of team members. Peer review
  - A project proposal will be reviewed by two faculty members and a student from different group. Randomly assigned. Follow the project up continuously until the Student Summit
- Review process → deliver suggestions, remarks, or criticism to the project, not to select
- Teleconference meeting, at the end of October 2015



# Running Project

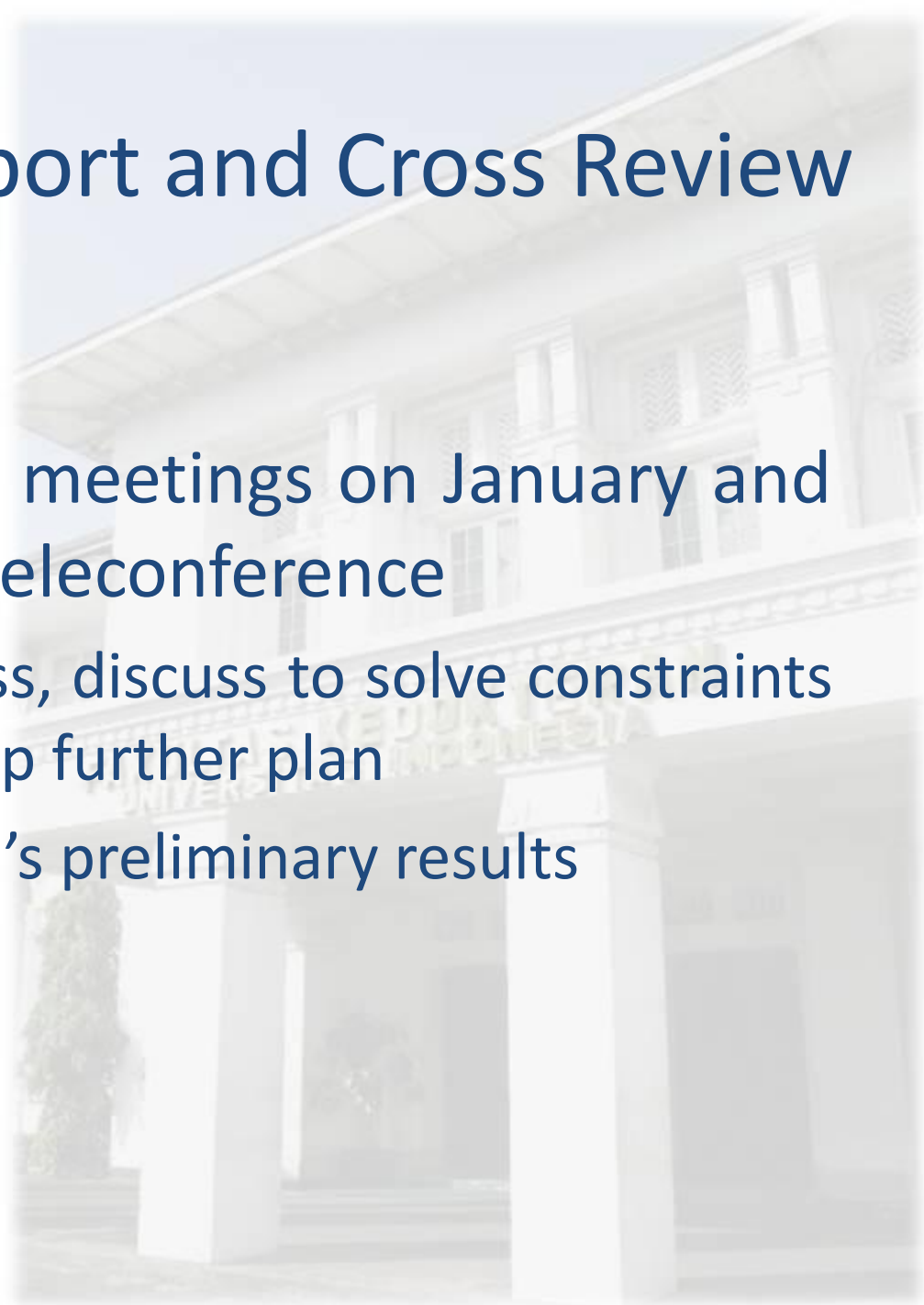
- November 2015 to July 2016
- Ad Hoc Committee will provide USD 1,000 per team
- Universities may use their own resources for additional funding. Some universities are allowed to generate cross country funding, if available





# Progress Report and Cross Review

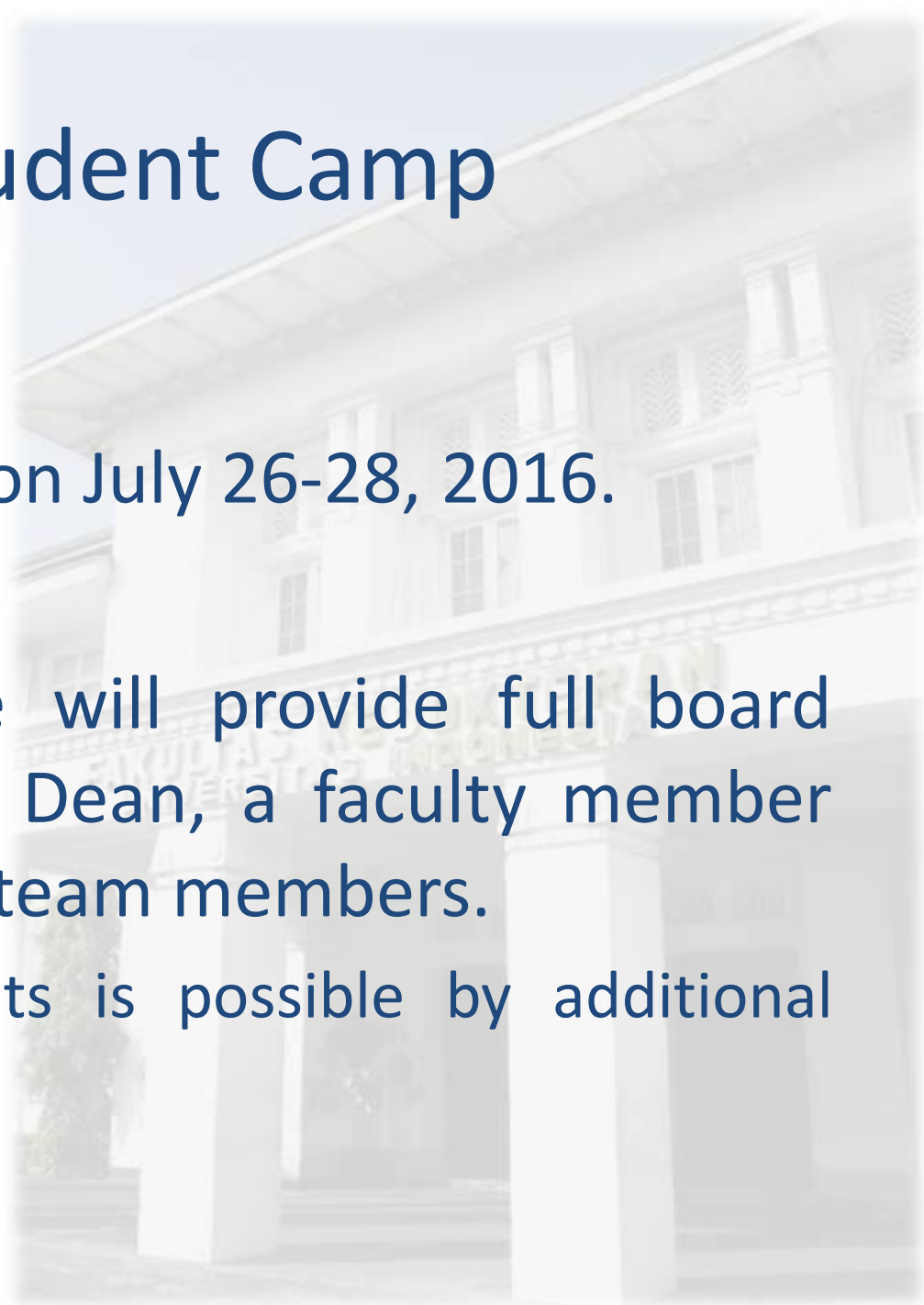
- Two progress report meetings on January and May 2016, through teleconference
  1. Review the progress, discuss to solve constraints (if any), and develop further plan
  2. Present the project's preliminary results

  - Additional attendants is possible by additional costs.

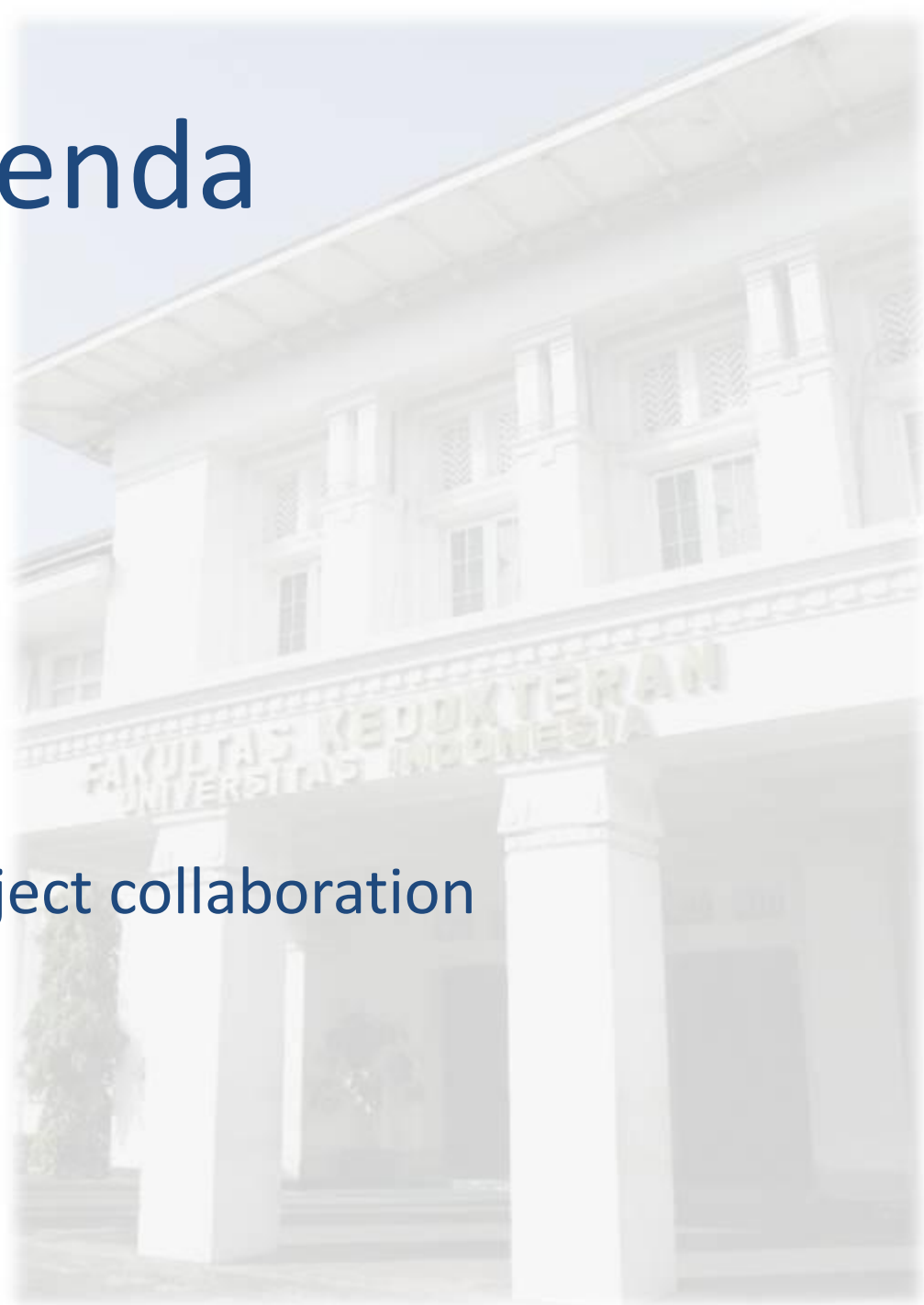

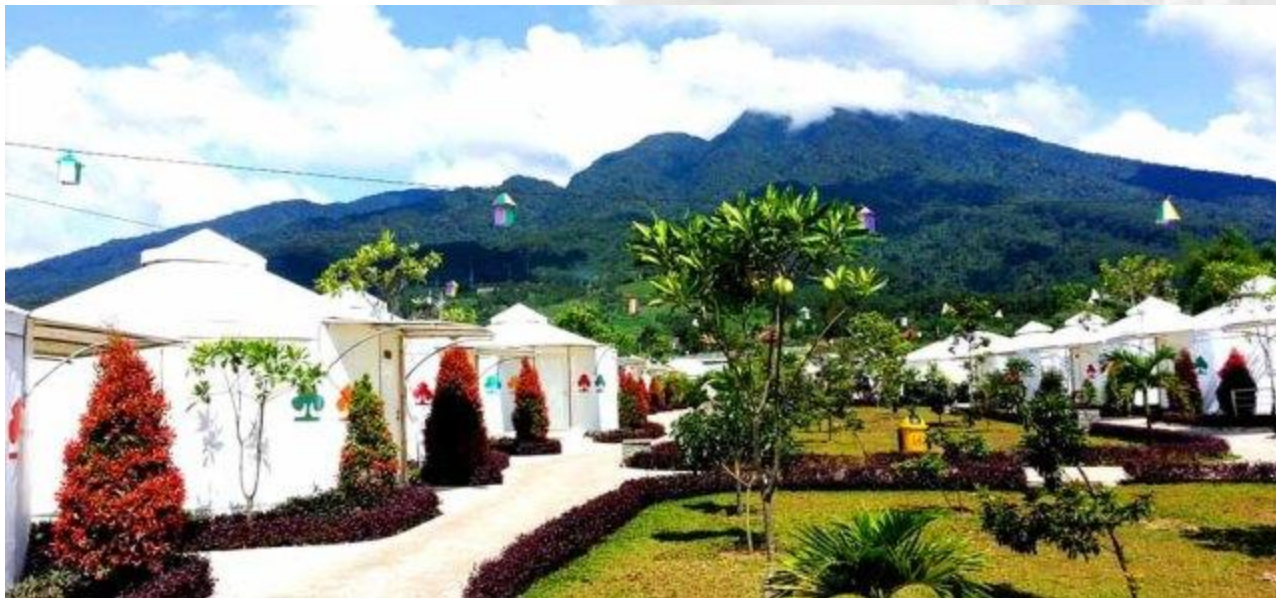
